



The Doctrine of the Holy Spirit - Part 6

Title: He will come upon Israel during the tribulation.



A. Rev. 7:2-4 NLT:

2 And I saw another angel coming up from the east, carrying the seal of the living God. And he shouted to those four angels, who had been given power to harm land and sea,

3 “Wait! Don’t harm the land or the sea or the trees until we have placed the seal of God on the foreheads of his servants.”

4 And I heard how many were marked with the seal of God— 144,000 were sealed from all the tribes of Israel:

Joel 2:28-32 NLT:

The LORD's Promise of His Spirit

28 “Then, after doing all those things,
I will pour out my Spirit upon all people.
Your sons and daughters will prophesy.
Your old men will dream dreams,
and your young men will see visions.

29 In those days I will pour out my Spirit
even on servants—men and women alike.

30 And I will cause wonders in the heavens and on the earth—
blood and fire and columns of smoke.

31 The sun will become dark,
and the moon will turn blood red
before that great and terrible day of the LORD arrives.

32 But everyone who calls on the name of the LORD
will be saved,
for some on Mount Zion in Jerusalem will escape,
just as the LORD has said.
These will be among the survivors
whom the LORD has called.

B. He will come upon Israel during the millennium.

Zech. 12:10 NLT:

10 “Then I will pour out a spirit of grace and prayer on the family of David and on the people of Jerusalem. They will look on me whom they have pierced and mourn for him as for an only son. They will grieve bitterly for him as for a firstborn son who has died.

Ezek. 37:13-14 NLT:

13 When this happens, O my people, you will know that I am the LORD.

14 I will put my Spirit in you, and you will live again and return home to your own land. Then you will know that I, the LORD, have spoken, and I have done what I said. Yes, the LORD has spoken!”

Ezek. 39:29 NLT:

29 And I will never again turn my face from them, for I will pour out my Spirit upon the people of Israel. I, the Sovereign LORD, have spoken!”





D. His ministry concerning the Savior. From his bodily conception to his final ascension, the Lord Jesus Christ was led by the Holy Spirit.

1. The Savior was begotten by the Holy Spirit.

Lk. 1:35 NLT:

35 The angel replied, “The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. So the baby to be born will be holy, and he will be called the Son of God.

Mt. 1:18-20 NLT:

The Birth of Jesus the Messiah

18 This is how Jesus the Messiah was born. His mother, Mary, was engaged to be married to Joseph. But before the marriage took place, while she was still a virgin, she became pregnant through the power of the Holy Spirit.

19 Joseph, to whom she was engaged, was a righteous man and did not want to disgrace her publicly, so he decided to break the engagement quietly.

20 As he considered this, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream. "Joseph, son of David," the angel said, "do not be afraid to take Mary as your wife. For the child within her was conceived by the Holy Spirit.

Thus the real Father of Christ's body was the Holy Spirit, and the real miracle was not in the Savior's birth, but in his supernatural conception.

E. The Savior was anointed by the Holy Spirit.

Mt. 3:16 NLT:

16 After his baptism, as Jesus came up out of the water, the heavens were opened and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and settling on him.



Lk. 4:18 NLT:

**18 “The Spirit of the LORD is upon me,
for he has anointed me to bring Good News to the poor.
He has sent me to proclaim that captives will be released,
that the blind will see,
that the oppressed will be set free,**

Acts 10:38 NLT:

38 And you know that God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power. Then Jesus went around doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with him.

Heb. 1:9 NLT:

9 You love justice and hate evil.
Therefore, O God, your God has anointed you,
pouring out the oil of joy on you more than on anyone else.”

F. The Savior was sealed by the Holy Spirit.

Jn. 6:27 NLT:

27 But don't be so concerned about perishable things like food. Spend your energy seeking the eternal life that the Son of Man can give you. For God the Father has given me the seal of his approval."

The seal here demonstrated the Son's identification with both Father and Spirit. It also spoke of his genuineness, value, and authority.

G. The Savior was led by the Holy Spirit.

Mt. 4:1 NLT:

The Temptation of Jesus

1 Then Jesus was led by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted there by the devil.

H. The Savior was empowered by the Holy Spirit.

Mt. 12:28 NLT:

28 But if I am casting out demons by the Spirit of God, then the Kingdom of God has arrived among you.

Phi 2:5-8 NLT:

5 You must have the same attitude that Christ Jesus had.

6 Though he was God,
he did not think of equality with God
as something to cling to.

7 Instead, he gave up his divine privileges;
he took the humble position of a slave
and was born as a human being.
When he appeared in human form,

8 he humbled himself in obedience to God
and died a criminal's death on a cross.

I. The Savior was filled by the Holy Spirit.

Jn. 3:34 NLT:

34 For he is sent by God. He speaks God's words, for God gives him the Spirit without limit.

Lk. 4:1 NLT:

The Temptation of Jesus

1 Then Jesus, full of the Holy Spirit, returned from the Jordan River. He was led by the Spirit in the wilderness

J. The Savior sorrowed in the Holy Spirit.

Jn. 11:33 NLT:

33 When Jesus saw her weeping and saw the other people wailing with her, a deep anger welled up within him, and he was deeply troubled

K. The Savior rejoiced in the Holy Spirit.

Lk. 10:21 NLT:

Jesus' Prayer of Thanksgiving

21 At that same time Jesus was filled with the joy of the Holy Spirit, and he said, “O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, thank you for hiding these things from those who think themselves wise and clever, and for revealing them to the childlike. Yes, Father, it pleased you to do it this way.

M. The Savior offered himself at Calvary through the Holy Spirit.



Heb. 9:14 NLT:

14 Just think how much more the blood of Christ will purify our consciences from sinful deeds so that we can worship the living God. For by the power of the eternal Spirit, Christ offered himself to God as a perfect sacrifice for our sins.



N. The Savior was raised from the dead by the Holy Spirit.

Rom. 1:4 NLT:

4 and he was shown to be the Son of God when he was raised from the dead by the power of the Holy Spirit.

1 Pet. 3:18 NLT:

18 Christ suffered for our sins once for all time. He never sinned, but he died for sinners to bring you safely home to God. He suffered physical death, but he was raised to life in the Spirit.

O. The Savior commanded his disciples after his resurrection through the Holy Spirit.

Acts 1:2 NLT:

2 until the day he was taken up to heaven after giving his chosen apostles further instructions through the Holy Spirit.

P. The Savior will someday return and raise the dead in Christ through the Holy Spirit.

Rom. 8:11 NLT:

11 The Spirit of God, who raised Jesus from the dead, lives in you. And just as God raised Christ Jesus from the dead, he will give life to your mortal bodies by this same Spirit living within you.



How do I ask Jesus to come into my life?
