Text: Mt. 28:19 NIV:

¹⁹Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,

I. Defining the word Holy Spirit:

Comes from the Greek word Pneuma; to breathe.

Breath, through, the mouth or nostrils, blast:

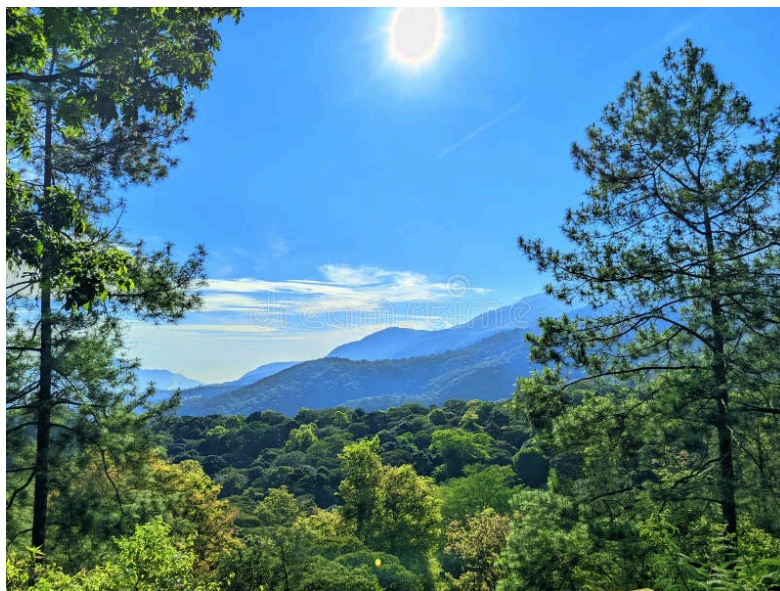
2 Thess. 2:8 NIV:

⁂And then the lawless one will be revealed, whom the Lord Jesus will overthrow with the breath of his mouth and destroy by the splendor of his coming.

A breath of air; air in motion, a breeze, blast, the wind:

Jn. 3:8 NIV:

⁂The wind blows wherever it pleases. You hear its sound, but you cannot tell where it comes from or where it is going. So it is with everyone born of the Spirit."



Defining Spirit.

The vital Spirit or life, the principle of life residing in man.
The breath breathed by God into a man and again returning to God, the spiritual entity in man.

i.e. Adam had a body, but no life:

Gen. 2:7 NIV:

⁷Then the LORD God formed a man from the dust of the ground and **breathed into his nostrils the breath of life, and the man became a living being.**

Ps. 104:29 NIV:

²⁹When you hide your face, they are terrified; when you take away their breath, they die and return to the dust.

Eccl. 12:7 NIV:

⁷and the dust returns to the ground it came from, and the spirit returns to God who gave it.



The Spirit in a man gives life to the body, so my words are Spirit and life to the soul.

1 Cor. 15:45 NIV:

⁴⁵So it is written: "The first man Adam became a living being"; the last Adam, a life-giving spirit.

Phil. 3:20-21: NIV:

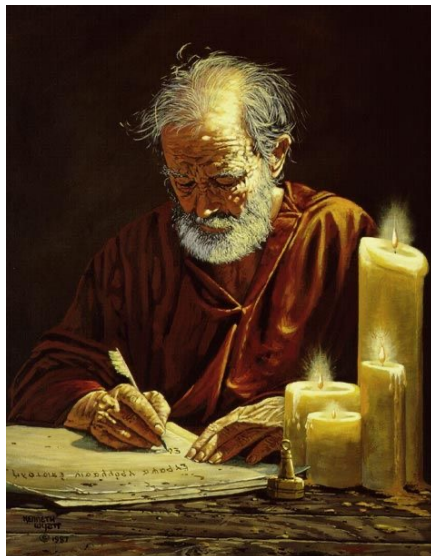
²⁰But our citizenship is in heaven. And we eagerly await a Savior from there, the Lord Jesus Christ,

²¹who, by the power that enables him to bring everything under his control, will transform our lowly bodies so that they will be like his glorious body.

The names and titles of the Holy Spirit.

The bible records thirteen names and titles ascribed to the - Holy Spirit:

1. The Spirit of God.

1 Cor. 3:16 NIV:

16Don't you know that you yourselves are God's temple and that God's Spirit dwells in your midst?

A. In this verse we find that the temple of God, the local church, is viewed as a temple of God inhabited by the Holy Spirit.

1 Cor. 6:19 NIV:

19Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own;

B. In this verse we find that temple of God is the individual person.

2. The Spirit of Christ.

Rom. 8:9 NIV:

9You, however, are not in the realm of the flesh but are in the realm of the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God lives in you. And if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, they do not belong to Christ.

3. The eternal Spirit.

Heb. 9:14 NIV:

14How much more, then, will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself unblemished to God, cleanse our consciences from acts that lead to death, so that we may serve the living God!

4. The Spirit of truth.

Jn. 16:13 NIV:

13But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all the truth. He will not speak on his own; he will speak only what he hears, and he will tell you what is yet to come.

5. The Spirit of grace.

Heb. 10:29 NIV:

29How much more severely do you think someone deserves to be punished who has trampled the Son of God underfoot, who has treated as an unholy thing the blood of the covenant that sanctified them, and who has insulted the Spirit of grace?

6. The Spirit of glory.

1 Pet. 4:14 NIV:

14If you are insulted because of the name of Christ, you are blessed, for the Spirit of glory and of God rests on you.

7. The Spirit of life.

Rom. 8:2 NIV:

2 because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit who gives life has set you free from the law of sin and death.

8. The Spirit of wisdom and revelation.

Eph. 1:17 NIV:

17 I keep asking that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and revelation, so that you may know him better.

9. The Comforter.

Jn. 14:26 KJV:

26 But the Comforter, *which is* the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.



10. The Spirit of promise.

Acts. 1:4-5 NIV:

4 On one occasion, while he was eating with them, he gave them this command: "Do not leave Jerusalem, but wait for the gift my Father promised, which you have heard me speak about.

5 For John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit."

11. The Spirit of adoption.

Rom. 8:15 NIV:

15 The Spirit you received does not make you slaves, so that you live in fear again; rather, the Spirit you received brought about your adoption to sonship. And by him we cry, "Abba, Father."

12. The Spirit of holiness.

Rom. 1:4 NIV:

4and who through the Spirit of holiness was appointed the Son of God in power by his resurrection from the dead: Jesus Christ our Lord.

13. The Spirit of faith.

2 Cor. 4:13 NIV:

13 It is written: "I believed; therefore I have spoken." Since we have that same spirit of faith, we also believe and therefore speak,
