All Are Under Sin

Galatians 3:22 NIV

But the Scripture has shut up all men under sin, that the promise by faith in Jesus Christ might be given to those who believe.



Romans 3:19 NIV

Now we know that whatever the Law says, it speaks to those who are under the Law, that every mouth may be closed, and all the world may become accountable to God;

Romans 5:12-15 NIV

Therefore, just as through one man sin entered into the world, and death through sin, and so death spread to all men, because all sinned—

13 for until the Law sin was in the world; but sin is not imputed when there is no law.

14 Nevertheless death reigned from Adam until Moses, even over those who had not sinned in the likeness of the offense of Adam, who is a type of Him who was to come.

15 But the free gift is not like the transgression.

For if by the transgression of the one the many died, much more did the grace of God and the gift by the grace of the one Man, Jesus Christ, abound to the many.

All of mankind without distinction are under the curse of sin and judged as sinful and separated from God apart from the saving grace of God in Christ.

All fall short of the glory of God—the immoral, moral, and religious:



Rom. 1:18-32 NIV

God's Wrath Against Sinful Humanity

¹⁸ The wrath of God is being revealed from heaven against all the godlessness and wickedness of people, who suppress the truth by their wickedness,

¹⁹ since what may be known about God is plain to them, because God has made it plain to them.

²⁰ For since the creation of the world God's invisible qualities—his eternal power and divine nature—have been clearly seen, being understood from what has been made, so that people are without excuse.

²¹ For although they knew God, they neither glorified him as God nor gave thanks to him, but their thinking became futile and their foolish hearts were darkened.

²² Although they claimed to be wise, they became fools

²³ and exchanged the glory of the immortal God for images made to look like a mortal human being and birds and animals and reptiles.

²⁴ Therefore God gave them over in the sinful desires of their hearts to sexual impurity for the degrading of their bodies with one another.

²⁵ They exchanged the truth about God for a lie, and worshiped and served created things rather than the Creator—who is forever praised. Amen.

²⁶ Because of this, God gave them over to shameful lusts. Even their women exchanged natural sexual relations for unnatural ones.

²⁷ In the same way the men also abandoned natural relations with women and were inflamed with lust for one another. Men committed shameful acts with other men, and received in themselves the due penalty for their error.

²⁸ Furthermore, just as they did not think it worthwhile to retain the knowledge of God, so God gave them over to a depraved mind, so that they do what ought not to be done.

²⁹ They have become filled with every kind of wickedness, evil, greed and depravity. They are full of envy, murder, strife, deceit and malice. They are gossips,

³⁰ slanderers, God-haters, insolent, arrogant and boastful; they invent ways of doing evil; they disobey their parents;

³¹ they have no understanding, no fidelity, no love, no mercy.

³² Although they know God's righteous decree that those who do such things deserve death, they not only continue to do these very things but also approve of those who practice them. We find that this always results in moral decay of man.

The Judgment to Moral Degeneration



According to **Romans 1:18-32**, when men turn away from the knowledge of God revealed so vividly in creation, God, as an expression of His holy wrath, turns men over to their own devices and foolish imaginations.

This always results in moral devolution and degeneration.

Paul teaches us that the varied forms of the awful sinfulness of man have their beginnings in the rejection of the revelation of God in creation.

Ungodliness is always the source of unrighteousness; ungodliness (turning away from God) leads to idolatry (man worshiping the products of his own mind and hands), and idolatry leads to unchained sensuality.

As they refused to follow the light, they were brought to folly in their thoughts—“became vain in their [corrupt] reasonings, and their foolish [senseless] heart was darkened.”

The intellectual revolt against what they knew to be right was attended by a darkening of the whole understanding.

The refusal to accept the truth destroys the power to discriminate between truth and error.

But this happens as a judgment from God against man's arrogant independence.

This condition is the expression of God's wrath (vs. 18) and twice we have the statement that this moral breakdown occurs because God "gave them over" (vss. 24 and 25).

Romans 1: 18, 24, 25:

1:18 wrath of God.

This is not an impulsive outburst of anger aimed capriciously at people whom God does not like.

²⁴ Therefore God gave them over in the sinful desires of their hearts to sexual impurity for the degrading of their bodies with one another.

²⁵ They exchanged the truth about God for a lie, and worshiped and served created things rather than the Creator—who is forever praised. Amen.

It is the settled, determined response of a righteous God against sin (cf. Pss. 2:5, 12; 45:7; 75:8; 76:6, 7; 78:49–51; 90:7–9; Is. 51:17; - Jer. 25:15, 16; John 3:36; Rom. 9:22; Eph. 5:6; Col. 3:5, 6).

That these aforementioned verses *reveal*.

More accurately, "is constantly revealed."


The word (WRATH) in the Greek, essentially means "to uncover, make visible, or make known."

God reveals His wrath in two ways:



indirectly, through the natural consequences of violating His universal moral law, and 2 directly through His personal intervention the OT record from the sentence passed on Adam and Eve to the worldwide flood, from the fire and brimstone that leveled Sodom to the Babylonian captivity clearly displays this kind of intervention).

The most graphic revelation of God's holy wrath and hatred against sin was when He poured out divine judgment on His Son on the cross.



God has various kinds of wrath:

- 1) Eternal wrath, which is hell;
- 2) Eschatological wrath, which is the final day of the Lord;
- 3) Cataclysmic wrath like the Flood and the destruction of Sodom and Gomorrah;
- 4) Consequential wrath, which is the principle of sowing and reaping; and
- 5) The wrath of abandonment, which is removing restraint and letting people go to their sins (for examples of this wrath, see: **Ps. 81:11,12:**

11

“But my people would not listen to me;
Israel would not submit to me.

12

So I gave them over to their stubborn hearts
to follow their own devices.

Prov. 1:23-31:

23

Repent at my rebuke!
Then I will pour out my thoughts to you,
I will make known to you my teachings.

24

But since you refuse to listen when I call
and no one pays attention when I stretch out my hand

25

since you disregard all my advice
and do not accept my rebuke,

26

I in turn will laugh when disaster strikes you;
I will mock when calamity overtakes you—

27

when calamity overtakes you like a storm,
when disaster sweeps over you like a whirlwind,
when distress and trouble overwhelm you.

28

“Then they will call to me but I will not answer;
they will look for me but will not find me,

29

since they hated knowledge
and did not choose to fear the Lord.

Hos. 4:17:

Ephraim is joined to idols; leave him alone!



Here, it is that fifth form, God's abandoning the wicked continually through history to pursue their sin and its consequences:



Romans 1: 24-32



This indicates a lack of reverence for, devotion to, and worship of the true God—a defective relationship with Him



Jude 14-15 NIV

14 Enoch, the seventh from Adam, prophesied about them: "See, the Lord is coming with thousands upon thousands of his holy ones

15 to judge everyone, and to convict all of them of all the ungodly acts they have committed in their ungodliness, and of all the defiant words ungodly sinners have spoken against him." *unrighteousness.*

This refers to the result of ungodliness:

A lack of conformity in thought, word, and deed to the character and law of God.



Romans 1:17 NIV

suppress the truth

17 For in the gospel the righteousness of God is revealed—
a righteousness that is by faith from first to last, just as it is written:

“The righteous will live by faith.”

Although the evidence from conscience:

1 Timothy 1:19 NIV

keeping faith and a good conscience, which some have rejected and
suffered shipwreck in regard to their faith.

Romans 2:14 NIV

14 (Indeed, when Gentiles, who do not have the law, do by nature things required by the law, they are a law for themselves, even though they do not have the law.

Romans 1:20 NIV

20 For since the creation of the world God's invisible qualities—his eternal power and divine nature—have been clearly seen, being understood from what has been made, so that people are without excuse. and God's Word is irrefutable, men choose to resist and oppose God's truth by holding fast to their sin:

Ps.14:1 NIV

1

The fool says in his heart,
"There is no God."

They are corrupt, their deeds are vile;
there is no one who does good.

John 3:19, 20 NIV

19 This is the verdict: Light has come into the world, but people loved darkness instead of light because their deeds were evil.

20 Everyone who does evil hates the light, and will not come into the light for fear that their deeds will be exposed.

Ephesians 4:17-19 NIV

17 This I say therefore, and affirm together with the Lord, that you walk no longer just as the Gentiles also walk, in the futility of their mind,

18 being darkened in their understanding, excluded from the life of God, because of the ignorance that is in them, because of the hardness of their heart;

19 and they, having become callous, have given themselves over to sensuality, for the practice of every kind of impurity with greediness.

The only exception is the person of Jesus Christ who, through the virgin birth, escaped the sin problem that is normally passed down from generation to generation.


Friends, at the end of the day:
