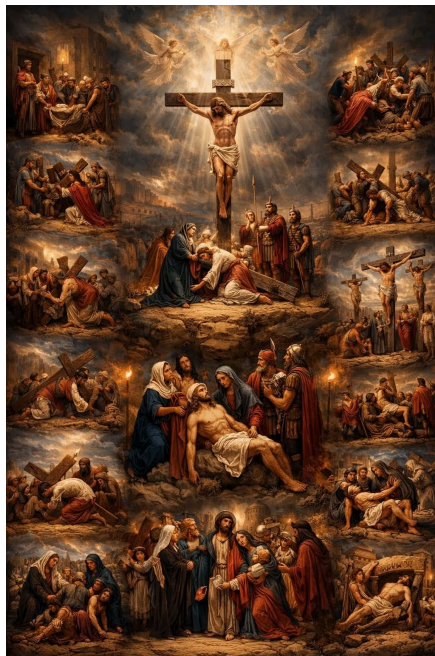


The Doctrine of the Son - Part 5

TEXT: MATTHEW 22:42 NIV:

42 "What do you think about the Messiah? Whose son is he?"
"The son of David," they replied.

I. JESUS' DEITY AS TAUGHT BY



A. PAUL: PHIL. 2:6-8 NIV:

⁶Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage;

⁷rather, he made himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness.

⁸And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to death even death on a cross!

B. PETER: 1 PETER 1:20 NIV:

20 He was chosen before the creation of the world, but was revealed in these last times for your sake.

C. JESUS:



JN. 6:51 NIV:

51 I am the living bread that came down from heaven. Whoever eats this bread will live forever. This bread is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world."

Jn. 6:61-62 NIV:

61 Aware that his disciples were grumbling about this, Jesus said to them, "Does this offend you?

62 Then what if you see the Son of Man ascend to where he was before!

JN. 8:58 NIV:

⁵⁸"Very truly I tell you," Jesus answered, "before Abraham was born, I am!"

Jn. 17:5 NIV:

5 And now, Father, glorify me in your presence with the glory I had with you before the world began.

In this verse, Jesus requests that the Father share in His glory.

However, in **Isaiah 42:8**, God declares that He would not share His name or glory with another!

Isa. 42:8 NIV:

⁸"I am the LORD; that is my name! I will not yield my glory to another or my praise to idols.

A. DEUTERONOMY 6: 4-5 NIV:

⁴Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one.

⁵Love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength.

B. 1 KINGS 8:60 NIV:

⁶⁰so that all the peoples of the earth may know that the LORD is God and that there is no other.

C. ISAIAH 44:6-8 NIV:

There Is No Other God

⁶"This is what the LORD says Israel's King and Redeemer, the LORD Almighty: I am the first and I am the last; apart from me there is no God.

⁷Who then is like me? Let him proclaim it. Let him declare and lay out before me what has happened since I established my ancient people, and what is yet to come yes, let them foretell what will come.

⁸Do not tremble, do not be afraid. Did I not proclaim this and foretell it long ago? You are my witnesses. Is there any God besides me? No, there is no other Rock; I know not one."

D. ISAIAH 45: 5-6 NIV:

⁵ I am the LORD, and there is no other; apart from me there is no God. I will strengthen you, though you have not acknowledged me,

⁶ so that from the rising of the sun to the place of its setting people may know there is none besides me. I am the LORD, and there is no other.

E. ISAIAH 46:9 NIV:

⁹Remember the former things, those of long ago; I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is none like me.

F. EPHESIANS 4:4-6 NIV:

⁴There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to one hope when you were called;

⁵one Lord, one faith, one baptism;

⁶one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all.

G. 1 TIMOTHY 2:5 NIV:

⁵For there is one God and one mediator between God and mankind, the man Christ Jesus,

MT.18:20 NIV:

²⁰ Then Peter came to Jesus and asked, "Lord, how many times shall I forgive my brother or sister who sins against me? Up to seven times?"

Mt. 28:20 NIV:

²⁰ and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

JN. 3:13 NIV:

¹³No one has ever gone into heaven except the one who came from heaven the Son of Man.

Jn. 14:20 NIV:

²⁰On that day you will realize that I am in my Father, and you are in me, and I am in you.

IV. HE is worshipped as GOD.

MT. 4:9-10 NIV:

⁹"All this I will give you," he said, "if you will bow down and worship me."

¹⁰Jesus said to him, "Away from me, Satan! For it is written: 'Worship the Lord your God, and serve him only.'"

By the angels: HEB.1:6 NIV:

⁶And again, when God brings his firstborn into the world, he says, "Let all God's angels worship him."

By the shepherds: **LK. 2:15 NIV:**

¹⁵When the angels had left them and gone into heaven, the shepherds said to one another, "Let's go to Bethlehem and see this thing that has happened, which the Lord has told us about."

By the wise men: **MT. 2:2 NIV:**

²and asked, "Where is the one who has been born king of the Jews? We saw his star when it rose and have come to worship him."

Mt. 2:11 NIV:

¹¹On coming to the house, they saw the child with his mother Mary, and they bowed down and worshiped him. Then they opened their treasures and presented him with gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh.

By a leper: **MT. 8:2 NIV:**

²A man with leprosy came and knelt before him and said, "Lord, if you are willing, you can make me clean."

By a ruler: **MT. 9:18 NIV:**

A Girl Restored to Life and a Woman Healed

¹⁸ While he was saying this, a synagogue leader came and knelt before him and said, "My daughter has just died. But come and put your hand on her, and she will live."

By a Syro - Phoenician woman: **MT. 15:25 NIV:**

²⁵ The woman came and knelt before him. "Lord, help me!" she said.

By a maniac: **MK. 5:6 NIV:**

⁶ When he saw Jesus from a distance, he ran and fell on his knees in front of him.

By a man born blind: **JN. 9:35-38 NIV:**

³⁵ Jesus heard that they had thrown him out, and when he found him, he said, "Do you believe in the Son of Man?"

³⁶ "Who is he, sir?" the man asked. "Tell me so that I may believe in him."

³⁷ Jesus said, "You have now seen him; in fact, he is the one speaking with you."

³⁸ Then the man said, "Lord, I believe," and he worshiped him.

By Thomas: **JN. 20:28 NIV:**

²⁸Thomas said to him, "My Lord and my God!"

By some Greeks: **JN. 12:20-21 NIV:**

Jesus Predicts His Death

²⁰Now there were some Greeks among those who went up to worship at the festival.

²¹They came to Philip, who was from Bethsaida in Galilee, with a request. "Sir," they said, "we would like to see Jesus."

By his Apostles: **MT. 14:33 NIV:**

³³Then those who were in the boat worshiped him, saying, "Truly you are the Son of God."

Mt. 28:9 NIV:

The Women Worship the Risen Lord

⁹Suddenly Jesus met them. "Greetings," he said. They came to him, clasped his feet and worshiped him.

VI. HE FORGIVES SINS.



Mk. 2:5 NIV:

⁵When Jesus saw their faith, he said to the paralyzed man, "Son, your sins are forgiven."

Mk. 10-11 NIV:

¹¹Jesus entered Jerusalem and went into the temple courts. He looked around at everything, but since it was already late, he went out to Bethany with the Twelve.

JN. 5:22 NIV:

²²that all may honor the Son just as they honor the Father. Whoever does not honor the Son does not honor the Father, who sent him.

¹⁵ which God will bring about in his own time God, the blessed and only Ruler, the King of kings and Lord of lords,



Bright Morning Star: **Rev. 22:16 NIV:**

¹⁶"I, Jesus, have sent my angel to give you this testimony for the churches. I am the Root and the Offspring of David, and the bright Morning Star."

Captain: **Josh. 5:14 NIV:**

¹⁴"Neither," he replied, "but as commander of the army of the LORD I have now come." Then Joshua fell facedown to the ground in reverence, and asked him, "What message does my Lord have for his servant?"

Carpenter: **Mt. 13:55 NIV:**

⁵⁵"Isn't this the carpenter's son? Isn't his mother's name Mary, and aren't his brothers James, Joseph, Simon and Judas?"
