**DOES GOD SHARE HIS NAME OR POSITION WITH ANYONE ?**

**ISAIAH 42:8 NIV:**

8 "I am the LORD; that is my name! I will not yield my glory to another or my praise to idols.

**The name of JESUS; SAVIOR:**

**THE GREEK** FORM OF THE NAME JOSHUA OR JESHUA, A CONTRACTION OF JEHOASHUA, THAT IS, " HELP OF JEHOVA "OR" SAVIOR.

**IN THE NEW TESTAMENT** THE NAME CHRIST IS USED AS EQUIVALENT TO THE HEBREW WORD MESSIAH ( Anointed ):

**Jn. 1:41 NIV:**

41The first thing Andrew did was to find his brother Simon and tell him, "We have found the Messiah" (that is, the Christ).

THE NAME OF JESUS IS THE PROPER NAME OF OUR LORD, AND THAT OF CHRIST IS ADDED TO IDENTIFY HIM WITH THE PROMISED MESSIAH: **Mt.11:1-3 NIV:**

**John the Baptist Sends Messengers to Jesus**

1After Jesus had finished instructing his twelve disciples, he went on from there to teach and preach in the towns of Galilee.

2When John, who was in prison, heard about the deeds of the Messiah, he sent his disciples

3to ask him, "Are you the one who is to come, or should we expect someone else?"

## **CONCLUSION:**

**The name of Jesus, means: the Lord is Salvation!**

**Are all the scriptures, the true word of God?**

### **2 Tim. 3:16-17 NIV:**

16All Scripture is **God-breathed** and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness,

17so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.

Translated from the Greek, the text employs a sail ship getting the winds that propels their sails and guides the ship.

**Theopneustos; means in the Greek: " God Breadth" or "Inspired by God"**

**God breathed** and conveyed HIS messages to all of the biblical writers, as HE guided them to write a verbatim account of His directives.

**Appearing in 2 Timothy 3:16 to describe the divine origin and authority of Scripture.**

**Coined by Paul, it signifies that all Scripture is breathed out by God, rather than merely containing human thoughts, making it profitable for teaching and equipping believers.**

## DOES JESUS PROCLAIM TO BE GOD ?



### **HE CREATED THE UNIVERSE: Heb. 1:2, and 10 NIV:**

2but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed heir of all things, and through whom also he made the universe.

10He also says, "In the beginning, Lord, you laid the foundations of the earth, and the heavens are the work of your hands.

## **HE IS CONTROLLING THE UNIVERSE: Col. 1:17 NIV:**

17He is before all things, and in him all things hold together.

## **HE WAS BEFORE THE FOUNDATIONS OF THE WORLD**

### **Jn. 17:24 NIV:**

24"Father, I want those you have given me to be with me where I am, and to see my glory, the glory you have given me because you loved me before the creation of the world.

## **HE SAYS HE IS THE WAY THE TRUTH AND THE LIFE**

### **Jn. 14:5-6 NIV:**

### **Jesus the Way to the Father**

5Thomas said to him, "Lord, we don't know where you are going, so how can we know the way?"

6Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.

### **Mt. 11:25-30 NIV:**

### **Jesus Gives True Rest**

25At that time Jesus said, "I praise you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because you have hidden these things from the wise and learned, and revealed them to little children.

26 Yes, Father, for this is what you were pleased to do.

27 "All things have been committed to me by my Father. No one knows the Son except the Father, and no one knows the Father except the Son and those to whom the Son chooses to reveal him.

28 "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest.

29 Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.

30 For my yoke is easy and my burden is light."

### **Mt. 16:13-17 NIV:**

## **Peter Confesses Jesus as the Christ**

13 When Jesus came to the region of Caesarea Philippi, he asked his disciples, "Who do people say the Son of Man is?"

14 They replied, "Some say John the Baptist; others say Elijah; and still others, Jeremiah or one of the prophets."

15 "But what about you?" he asked. "Who do you say I am?"

16 Simon Peter answered, "You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God."

17 Jesus replied, "Blessed are you, Simon son of Jonah, for this was not revealed to you by flesh and blood, but by my Father in heaven.

## **PURSUANT TO DISCOVERING WHOM JESUS IS, WHAT ARE WE SUPPOSE TO DO ?**



### **COLOSSIANS 2:6-7 NIV:**

#### **Spiritual Fullness in Christ**

6 So then, just as you received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to live your lives in him,

7 rooted and built up in him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness.

1. We discover that we have been saved in Christ Jesus.
2. We walk in Him.
3. We learn in Him.
4. We are to build upon established faith in Him.
5. We are to receive His teachings.
6. We are called to stay with God through good and bad, with a heart of Thanksgiving!

## **1 Peter 4:1 NIV:**

### **Living for God**

1Therefore, since Christ suffered in his body, arm yourselves also with the same attitude, because whoever suffers in the body is done with sin.

## **THE DUTY OF JESUS CHRIST:**

### **As shown by the Old Testament:**

#### **1. The witness of David: Psalms 45:6 NIV:**

6Your throne, O God, will last for ever and ever; a scepter of justice will be the scepter of your kingdom.

#### **2. The witness of Isaiah: Isa. 9:6 NIV:**

6For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

### **3. The witness of Daniel: Dan. 7:13-14 NIV:**

13 "In my vision at night I looked, and there before me was one like a son of man, coming with the clouds of heaven. He approached the Ancient of Days and was led into his presence.

14 He was given authority, glory and sovereign power; all nations and peoples of every language worshiped him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion that will not pass away, and his kingdom is one that will never be destroyed.



### **As shown by the Gospels:**

#### **1. He is Omnipotent: Mt. 28:18 NIV:**

18 Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me.

### **A. Over Disease: Lk. 4:39 NIV:**

39So he bent over her and rebuked the fever, and it left her. She got up at once and began to wait on them.

### **B. Over Demons; Lk. 4:35 NIV:**

35"Be quiet!" Jesus said sternly. "Come out of him!" Then the demon threw the man down before them all and came out without injuring him.

### **C. Over Men: Mt. 9:9 NIV:**

## **Matthew the Tax Collector**

9As Jesus went on from there, he saw a man named Matthew sitting at the tax collector's booth. "Follow me," he told him, and Matthew got up and followed him.

### **D. Over Nature: Mt. 8:26 NIV:**

26He replied, "You of little faith, why are you so afraid?" Then he got up and rebuked the winds and the waves, and it was completely calm.

### **E. Over Sin: Mt. 9:1-8 NIV:**

## **Jesus Forgives and Heals a Paralytic**

1Jesus stepped into a boat, crossed over and came to his own town.

2Some men brought to him a paralyzed man, lying on a mat. When Jesus saw their faith, he said to the man, "Take heart, son; your sins are forgiven."

3At this, some of the teachers of the law said to themselves, "This fellow is blaspheming!"

4Knowing their thoughts, Jesus said, "Why do you entertain evil thoughts in your hearts?"

5Which is easier: to say, 'Your sins are forgiven,' or to say, 'Get up and walk'?

6But I want you to know that the Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins." So he said to the paralyzed man, "Get up, take your mat and go home."

7Then the man got up and went home.

8When the crowd saw this, they were filled with awe; and they praised God, who had given such authority to man.

## **F. Over Traditions: Mt. 9:10-17 NIV:**

<sup>10</sup>While Jesus was having dinner at Matthew's house, many tax collectors and sinners came and ate with him and his disciples.

11When the Pharisees saw this, they asked his disciples, "Why does your teacher eat with tax collectors and sinners?"

12On hearing this, Jesus said, "It is not the healthy who need a doctor, but the sick.

13But go and learn what this means: 'I desire mercy, not sacrifice.' For I have not come to call the righteous, but sinners."

### **Jesus Is Questioned About Fasting**

14Then John's disciples came and asked him, "How is it that we and the Pharisees fast often, but your disciples do not fast?"

15Jesus answered, "How can the guests of the bridegroom mourn while he is with them? The time will come when the bridegroom will be taken from them; then they will fast.

16"No one sews a patch of un-shrunk cloth on an old garment, for the patch will pull away from the garment, making the tear worse.

17Neither do people pour new wine into old wineskins. If they do, the skins will burst; the wine will run out and the wineskins will be ruined. No, they pour new wine into new wineskins, and both are preserved."

### **G. Over Death: Lk. 7:14-15 NIV:**

14Then he went up and touched the bier they were carrying him on, and the bearers stood still. He said, "Young man, I say to you, get up!"

15The dead man sat up and began to talk, and Jesus gave him back to his mother.

## **HE is Omniscient: Jn. 2:24 and 16:30 NIV:**

24But Jesus would not entrust himself to them, for he knew all people.

30Now we can see that you know all things and that you do not even need to have anyone ask you questions. This makes us believe that you came from God.”

## **HE knew the whereabouts of Nathaniel: Jn. 1:48 NIV:**

48"How do you know me?" Nathanael asked. Jesus answered, "I saw you while you were still under the fig tree before Philip called you."

## **HE knew the plot of Judas Iscariot: Jn.6:70 and 13:11 NIV:**

70Then Jesus replied, "Have I not chosen you, the Twelve? Yet one of you is a devil!"

11For he knew who was going to betray him, and that was why he said not every one was clean.

## **HE knew the hearts of the Pharisees: Lk. 5:22 NIV:**

22Jesus knew what they were thinking and asked, "Why are you thinking these things in your hearts?"

## **HE knew the thoughts of the scribes: Mt. 9:3-4 NIV:**

34But the Pharisees said, "It is by the prince of demons that he drives out demons."

## **HE knew the sincerity of one scribe: Mt. 12:34 NIV:**

34You brood of vipers, how can you who are evil say anything good? For the mouth speaks what the heart is full of.

## **HE knew the history of the Samaritan woman: Jn. 4:29 NIV:**

29"Come, see a man who told me everything I ever did. Could this be the Messiah?"

## **Jesus knew the thoughts and the hearts of His Disciples:**

### **Lk. 9:46-47 NIV:**

46An argument started among the disciples as to which of them would be the greatest.

47Jesus, knowing their thoughts, took a little child and had him stand beside him.





## **Biblical names and titles of Christ Jesus:**

**Babe: Lk. 2:46 NIV:**

<sup>46</sup>After three days they found him in the temple courts, sitting among the teachers, listening to them and asking them questions.

**Beginning of Creation: Rev. 3:14 NIV:**

**To the Church in Laodicea**

<sup>14</sup>"To the angel of the church in Laodicea write: These are the words of the Amen, the faithful and true witness, the ruler of God's creation.

**Begotten of the Father: Jn. 1:14 NIV:**

<sup>14</sup>The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.

**Beloved: Eph. 1:6 NIV:**

6 to the praise of his glorious grace, which he has freely given us in the One he loves.

**Bishop: 1 PETER 2:25 NIV:**

25For "you were like sheep going astray," but now you have returned to the Shepherd and Overseer of your souls.
