can ever hear**

Text: Matthew 25:31-38, 41 NIV:

The Son of Man Will Judge the Nations

31 "When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, he will sit on his glorious throne.

32 All the nations will be gathered before him, and he will separate the people one from another as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats.

33 He will put the sheep on his right and the goats on his left.

34 "Then the King will say to those on his right, 'Come, you who are blessed by my Father; take your inheritance, the kingdom prepared for you since the creation of the world.

35 For I was hungry and you gave me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you invited me in,

36 I needed clothes and you clothed me, I was sick and you looked after me, I was in prison and you came to visit me.'

37 "Then the righteous will answer him, 'Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you something to drink?

38 When did we see you a stranger and invite you in, or needing clothes and clothe you?

- I. Introduction: The most terrible person, place, words, people, or inhabitants, or the most terrible state.**
 - A. Most terrible person: Jesus Christ to Sinners.
 - B. Most terrible words: “ Depart from ME, Ye Cursed, into Everlasting Fire!
 - C. Most terrible place: Is Hell, where the Fire is Never Doused or Quenched!
 - D. The most terrible people or inhabitants: The Devil and his angels.
 - E. The most terrible state: is to be sentenced, or to be locked in for **ETERNITY in hell.** (**A Permanent & Unchangeable state of being**).

II. A Pictorial View at Jesus:

The last time the world saw Jesus, He was on a cross. The Bible teaches that there were Four groups of persons who were looking at Jesus while on the cross:



1. John (The beloved disciple), and his brother, with a group of courageous women among which was Mary, Jesus' Mother, the rest of the disciples had fled! This section of scripture teaches that women were more courageous than men.
2. Religious people: who were Mocking God!
3. Two Criminals; Dismas and Getmas, of which Getmas, was talking back to Jesus.

4. Israeli citizens that were transient observers whom were nodding in disapproval of the sacrifice that Christ Jesus was performing. These people also Mocked our Lord. So our last glimpse of Jesus wasn't a favorable picture.

III. **A WORLDWIDE MOCKERY:**



Matthew 27:39: What a fool, they were reviling Him!

39 Those who passed by hurled insults at him, shaking their heads

Matthew 27:40:

40and saying, "You who are going to destroy the temple and build it in three days, save yourself! Come down from the cross, if you are the Son of God!"

Another group espousing their views!

Matthew 27:41:

41In the same way the chief priests, the teachers of the law and the elders mocked him.

Religious leaders who were taking Jesus' sermons and His words to Mock Him!

Matthew 27:44:

44In the same way the rebels who were crucified with him also heaped insults on him.

The criminals literally sucker-punched Jesus with their railing accusations.

In conclusion, three out of these four groups did not speak well of Jesus!

IV. Prophecies Fulfill Themselves:



A. ISA. 53:3-5, 7: HE opened not His mouth!

3He was despised and rejected by mankind, a man of suffering, and familiar with pain. Like one from whom people hide their faces he was despised, and we held him in low esteem.

4Surely he took up our pain and bore our suffering, yet we considered him punished by God, stricken by him, and afflicted.

5But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on him, and by his wounds we are healed.

7He was oppressed and afflicted, yet he did not open his mouth; he was led like a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before its shearers is silent, so he did not open his mouth

B. Jesus says : “ My GOD why have YOU FORSAKEN ME !”

**C. Jesus says to the religious leaders and others :
" Father Forgive Them .”**

D. To His mother: " Woman behold your Son and instructs (John), to care for His mother.

E. Jesus says: “ I thirst.”

F. Jesus said to the criminal who repented:

“ Today, you will be with me in Paradise because you have repented from your past mocking of me, and of from your past transgressions”

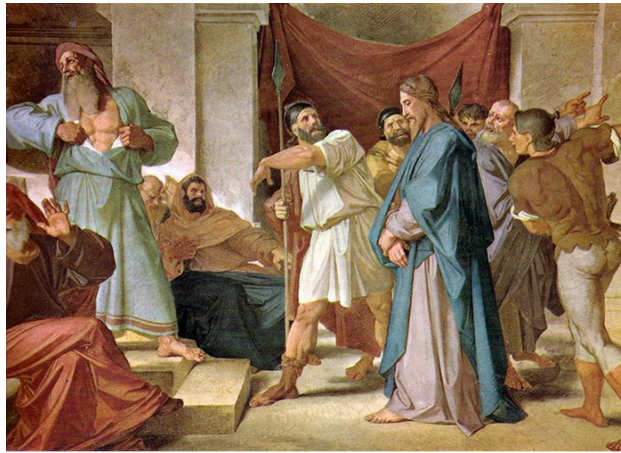
v. Jesus’ last words on the cross:



His words to humanity aren't harsh, abrasive, scornful, hateful, words, they were soothing, loving, words;

“ Father Forgive them for they know not.”

VI. JESUS' WORDS UPON HIS SECOND COMING :

Matthew 25:31:

31 "When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, he will sit on his glorious throne.

A. In my first coming, I spoke of salvation, love, and repentance. I was a lamb of offering.

B. Matthew 25:41: An exegesis on the word SAY :

41"Then he will say to those on his left, 'Depart from me, you who are cursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels.

In the Greek the word Say; has several meanings:

Laleo:

A child learning to speak, for instance, "Dada," "Mommy," "That's speech you can hear," but sometimes it's un-intangible.

However, God isn't a drunkard or a mad man.

When He speaks, it's perceptibly clear what He means to say!

Lego:

To deliver a sermon, but Jesus won't be giving any more sermons, nor will there be any more Sunday schools because preaching has ceased to exist at this juncture.

The salvation message has ceased it's Over!

Ereo:

The word to be utilized in this text is the Greek word "**erēo**," which means "to pronounce" or "to make a declaration that cannot be changed."

VII. The Police Officers of Judgement:

Matthew 25:46:

46"Then they will go away to eternal punishment, but the righteous to eternal life."

A. "Depart from me" this is a twofold message:

Jesus is directing the angels to take, and place, Mr. or Mrs., so and so, and place them in Hell.

Jesus tells Mr. or Mrs. that your final destination is hell!

Matthew 13:41-42:

41The Son of Man will send out his angels, and they will weed out of his kingdom everything that causes sin and all who do evil.

42They will throw them into the blazing furnace, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

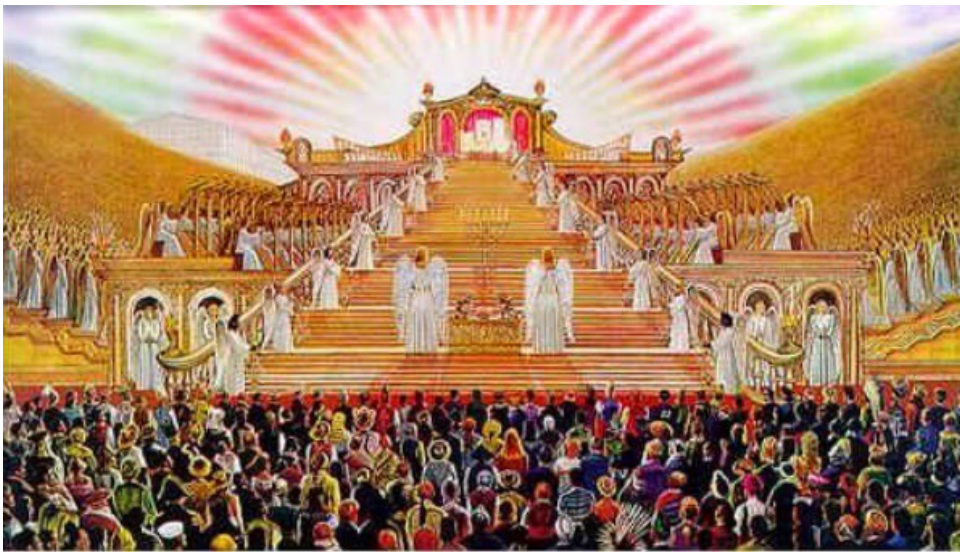
Matthew 13:49-50:

49This is how it will be at the end of the age. The angels will come and separate the wicked from the righteous

50and throw them into the blazing furnace, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

Imagine this event will separate families, friends, acquaintances, neighbors, co-workers, for Eternity!

VIII. The witnesses of the Final Judgment and Advent of Jesus' Second Coming:



Revelation 1:7:

7"Look, he is coming with the clouds," and "every eye will see him, even those who pierced him"; and all peoples on earth "will mourn because of him." So shall it be! Amen.



IX. The Consequences of rejecting Jesus Christ:

Matthew 25:41:

41 "Then he will say to those on his left, 'Depart from me, you who are cursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels.

“Ye cursed” in the Greek means to have a prayer said against you.”

It's the Greek word Cataromi: to say something down

Cata: Down - Romi: To Say

FOR OVER 2,000 YEARS JESUS' HAS BEEN PRAYING GOOD THINGS FOR **ROMANS 8:34 NIV:**

34 Who then is the one who condemns? No one. Christ Jesus who died more than that, who was raised to life is at the right hand of God and is also interceding for us.

JESUS ISN'T AGAINST US RIGHT NOW, HEBREWS 7:25 NIV:

25 Therefore he is able to save completely those who come to God through him, because he always lives to intercede for them.

GOD doesn't want Final and Everlasting Fire for anyone of us.



However, Jesus at the end of time, He will say to Mr. Or Mrs. So & So, I reached out to you, I came to save you, I wanted to have fellowship with you, but you DENIED me, now I'm the one Denying you!

What would be your destiny, if Jesus came back Today?
